

Agenda for Gourd Classes:

1st Class June 20: Basic On Gourds, we will show the different products to use, gourds and other items.

Students will buy a gourd and clean it for the next class.

Students are to purchase their own gourd, to have for the 2nd Class

2nd Class July 18: Learning Leather Dyes: You will cut and clean the inside of the gourd that was cleaned at the first class. We will then apply leather dyes to our gourd. Students may choose to do a bowl or a bowl with lid. Embellishments will be available to use on your gourds also. Students will leave with a finished gourd.

Cost of this class is \$15.00 - supplies will be furnished.

Students will have to purchase another gourd for the 3rd class.

3rd Class August 15: You will cut and clean a gourd that you purchased at the 2nd class. You will paint and complete a Birdhouse. You will be able to paint the gourd any way you choose.

The cost of the class will be \$15.00.

Students will have to purchase another gourd for the 4th Class.

4th Class Sept 12: Getting to know Ink Dyes; you will wood burn a leaf on a gourd and use the ink dyes to color it in. The ink dyes a make beautiful finished product.

The cost of this class is \$20.00 - and the supplies will be furnished.

We have supplies on hand if you want to purchase some for your own.

5th Class Oct. 3. You will cut and clean a gourd to look like a pumpkin. You will cut the eyes, nose and mouth out. You will paint and have it ready to add to your decorations for Halloween. You will have to purchase your own lights, that can be found at Wal-Mart.

The cost of this class will be \$20.00.- Paints will be furnished. OR

You can get your paints at Wal-Mart.

6th Class Nov. 14: You will cut pieces from gourds and do a beaded ornament. You can choose to do Poinsettia.

This class will run on over into our Dec. Class, as this is a time consuming to do.. After the piece is done you will finish the sides of it, and add a beaded hanger. You will have a very precious piece to hang on your tree for Christmas. You will be furnished enough products to carry home with you to work on it at home also.
