Description: Detail instructions given by the instructor as well as receive a book with detail instructions and photos giving students step-by-step instructions of how to do a quail on a gourd. Learn how to woodburn details, small feathers, rocks, bushes, ground cover, etc. Color will be added to the design. Pattern will be put on by students. **NOTE:** Design will be a little different.

Materials Supplied by Instructor: *(If none are needed, write none.)*
Waterbased dyes, acrylic paints, nib cleaning supplies, brushes, and instructional book that the students will take home with them. Tracing and transfer paper, pattern, and pencils for putting design on the gourd.

Materials Supplied by Students: *(If none are needed, write none.)*
[Clean and Uncut Gourd](#) - **Must** have an area large enough on one side to accommodate a 6” wide and 4 ½” high pattern with 1” above the patten. Price for class reflects students bringing their own gourd.
[Woodburner](#) - Professional burner is best. If you don’t have one, bring a Woodcraft or similar burner.
[Nibs/Pens](#) - Your favorite ones that can be used as a liner and/or shader.

Teachers provide gourds, extension cords, power strips, and tables. Volunteers will help you unload your vehicle. --- Received approval from your president, Gale Keys, for the students to furnish their own gourds in all my classes. Also, informed by Madge that tables would be furnished for students, but I will bring one for me.
